The purpose of this class – the song in your heart¹

Do you have a favorite song?

- it has a pattern of notes and rhythms
- it stays in your heart, and you keep singing it
- you remember it (Tommy)
- it gives you goosebumps or chills when you hear it (band)
- you want to keep having that feeling

We try to keep that feeling sometimes with the wrong things

- comfort food or entertainment
- thrill rides and other activities
- perhaps drugs

I want to help you see the pattern of Truth and God with such power that it will stay with you forever!

The pattern on the mountain - overview

God directed Moses to build the tabernacle according to the pattern He gave Him.

Look at the emphasis on the pattern.

The pattern on the mountain (1)

The LORD said to Moses... Make this tabernacle and all its furnishings exactly like the pattern I will show you. Have them make a chest of acacia wood -- two and a half cubits long, a cubit and a half wide, and a cubit and a half high. Overlay it with pure gold, both inside and out, and make a gold molding around it. Cast four gold rings for it and fasten them to its four feet, with two rings on one side and two rings on the other. Then make poles of acacia wood and overlay them with gold. Insert the poles into the rings on the sides of the chest to carry it. The poles are to remain in the rings of this ark; they are not to be removed. Then put in the ark the Testimony, which I will give you.

Exodus 25:9-16

The pattern on the mountain (2) preparing a place to meet God

Make an atonement cover of pure gold -- two and a half cubits long and a cubit and a half wide. And make two cherubim out of hammered gold at the ends of the cover. Make one cherub on one end and the second cherub on the other; make the cherubim of one piece with the cover, at the two ends. The cherubim are to have their wings spread upward, overshadowing the cover with them. The cherubim are to face each other, looking toward the cover. Place the cover on top of the ark and put in the ark the Testimony, which I will give you.

There, above the cover between the two cherubim that are over the ark of the Testimony, I will meet with you and give you all my commands for the Israelites. Exodus 25:16-

The pattern on the mountain (3)

Make a table of acacia wood... make its plates and dishes of pure gold, as well as its pitchers and bowls... a lampstand of pure gold...

See that you make them according to the pattern shown you on the mountain.

Make the tabernacle with ten curtains of finely twisted linen and blue, purple and scarlet yarn, with cherubim worked into them by a skilled craftsman...

Set up the tabernacle according to the plan shown you on the mountain.

Build an altar of acacia wood... Make the altar hollow, out of boards. It is to be made just as you were shown on the mountain. Make a courtyard for the tabernacle. Exodus 25:22-40, Exodus 26:29-30, Exodus 27:8-9

The pattern on the mountain (4) preparing a place to meet God

Then the LORD said to Moses,

"Take fragrant spices... and make a fragrant blend of incense, the work of a perfumer.

It is to be salted and pure and sacred.

Grind some of it to powder and place it in front of the Testimony in the Tent of Meeting, where I will meet with you.

It shall be most holy to you.

Do not make any incense with this formula for yourselves; consider it holy to the LORD.

Whoever makes any like it to enjoy its fragrance must be cut off from his people."

Exodus 30:34-38

Then the LORD said to Moses...

I have given skill to all the craftsmen to make everything I have commanded you: the Tent of Meeting, the ark of the Testimony with the atonement cover on it, and all the other furnishings of the tent -- the table and its articles, the pure gold lampstand and all its accessories, the altar of incense, the altar of burnt offering and all its utensils, the basin with its stand -- and also the woven garments, both the sacred garments for Aaron the priest and the garments for his sons when they serve as priests, and the anointing oil and fragrant incense for the Holy Place. They are to make them just as I commanded you."

The pattern on the mountain (6)

- garments... as the LORD commanded Moses.
- **ephod**... as the LORD commanded Moses.
- memorial stones... as the LORD commanded Moses.
- breastpiece... as the LORD commanded Moses.
- robe... as the LORD commanded Moses.
- tunics, headbands, undergarments, sash... as the LORD commanded Moses.
- sacred diadem... as the LORD commanded Moses.
- So all the work on the tabernacle, the Tent of Meeting, was completed. The Israelites did everything just as the LORD commanded Moses.

Moses inspected the work and saw that they had done it just as the LORD had commanded. So Moses blessed them.

Exodus 39:1-41

The pattern on the mountain (7)

Moses did everything just as the LORD commanded him. Then he spread the tent over the tabernacle and put the covering over the tent, as the LORD commanded him. Then he brought the ark into the tabernacle... as the LORD commanded him. Moses placed the table... and set out the bread on it before the LORD, as the LORD commanded him. He placed the lampstand... and set up the lamps before the LORD, as the LORD commanded him. Moses placed the gold altar... and burned fragrant incense on it, as the LORD commanded him. He set the altar... and offered on it burnt offerings... as the LORD commanded him. He placed the basin... for washing, as the LORD commanded Moses.

Exodus 40:16-32

The pattern on the mountain – God's Presence

And so Moses finished the work.

- Then the cloud covered the Tent of Meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.
- Moses could not enter the Tent of Meeting because the cloud had settled upon it, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.
- In all the travels of the Israelites, whenever the cloud lifted from above the tabernacle, they would set out; but if the cloud did not lift, they did not set out -- until the day it lifted.
- So the cloud of the LORD was over the tabernacle by day, and fire was in the cloud by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel during all their travels.

Exodus 40:33-38

The pattern on the mountain – the lampstand

This is how the lampstand was made:

It was made of hammered gold – from its base to its blossoms.

The lampstand was made exactly like the pattern the LORD had shown Moses.

Numbers 8:4

The pattern on the mountain – NT summary

Our forefathers had the tabernacle of the Testimony with them in the desert.

It had been made as God directed Moses, according to the pattern he had seen.

Acts 7:44

They serve at a sanctuary that is a copy and shadow of what is in heaven.

The pattern on the mountain – comments (1) 2

- God demanded absolute adherence to the plan for the tabernacle
- Moses led the people and they delivered the tabernacle according to the instructions
- What was God really after?
 - A perfect tabernacle?
 - Could this physical perfection really mean anything to God?
 - "The multitude of your sacrifices-- what are they to me?" says the LORD. "I have more than enough of burnt offerings, of rams and the fat of fattened animals; I have no pleasure in the blood of bulls and lambs and goats. (Isaiah 1:11)
- Did the pattern God presented for the tabernacle, or its building exactly according to the pattern,

help people to develop a better relationship with God?

The pattern on the mountain – comments (2)

2

- The patriarchs had a personal relationship with God
- The people of Israel in general were not ready for the power of proximity to God
- The formal, rigid pattern kept God beyond their reach
- The people needed the priesthood to connect them to God
- God wanted a people, but they had to want Him as their God

Is obedience without love pleasing to God?

The pattern on the mountain – comments (3)

• The law was given before the people were able to see the importance of the relationship –

and was given to promote the development of the relationship

- The law alone does not have the proper depth to probe the heart
- The human high priests did not have the power to maintain the personal connection with God and His people

OT: LAW

NT: RELATIONSHIP

What is the Pattern that God really wants from us?

Using the pattern to establish righteousness

- The 10 Commandments were a pattern to follow
 - They were a foundation to build on
 - We must not forget how we must act towards our neighbor
- The prophets were involved in pointing to a new, more personal pattern
 - They began unfolding message to show the coming pattern
- Pharisees missed the point, and tried to defend their pattern to Jesus and His followers
- We may use the pattern of the structure we perceive to establish our righteousness

– Does it really match the pattern that God is after?

The pattern on the mountain – a copy of the True²

How the Tabernacle Pattern Changed (1)

- When Christ came as high priest of the good things that are already here, he went through the greater and more perfect tabernacle that is not man-made, that is to say, not a part of this creation.
- He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, having obtained eternal redemption.
- ... He sprinkled with the blood both the tabernacle and everything used in its ceremonies. In fact, the law requires that nearly everything be cleansed with blood...

Hebrews 9:11-12, 21

Hebrews is all about the superiority of Christ to the pattern established in the Old Testament

How the Tabernacle Pattern Changed (2)

- It was necessary, then, for the copies of the heavenly things to be purified with these sacrifices, but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these.
- For Christ did not enter a man-made sanctuary that was only a copy of the true one; he entered heaven itself, now to appear for us in God's presence.
- Nor did he enter heaven to offer himself again and again, the way the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood that is not his own.
- ... He has appeared once for all at the end of the ages to do away with sin by the sacrifice of Himself.

Hebrews 9:22-26

Not just a copy in place, but in time.

The Law is Only a Shadow

- The law is only a shadow of the good things that are coming not the realities themselves.
- For this reason it can never, by the same sacrifices repeated endlessly year after year, make perfect those who draw near to worship.
- Day after day every priest stands and performs his religious duties; again and again he offers the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins.
- But when this priest [*Christ*] had offered for all time one sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God [*finished*].

Hebrews 10:1, 11-12

Christ's effectiveness was infinitely superior to the old pattern (once vs endless).

Can we pick the right thread out of the pattern? ³

- Narrow is the way and few there be that find it (Matthew 7:13-14, Luke 13:24)
 - Many people do not get the point
 - Many people cannot see the thread of truth
 - Many people cannot see the forest for the trees
- We need to be able to see the thread of Good (God)





Do we need spiritual glasses?

For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love.

For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

But if anyone does not have them, he is nearsighted and blind, and has forgotten that he has been cleansed from his past sins.

- How clear is God's pattern?
 - Do we have a beam or a speck in our eye?

"Why do you look at the speck of sawdust in your brother's eye and pay no attention to the plank in your own eye? How can you say to your brother, 'Let me take the speck out of your eye,' when all the time there is a plank in your own eye? You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's **Matthew 7:3-5** eye.

We have one or the other!

- help organize
- help understand
- inspire
- please us aesthetically
- attract our attention
- guide us (keep us from getting lost)

This would take a lot out of life...

- My Dad would talk in amazement about the pattern of contrails in the sky
 - Where were they all going?
 - Think of the patterns he sees now in heaven!

Patterns be Used in a Good or Bad Way

"You shall not make for yourself an idol [KJV: graven image] in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below.

- Is using an icon like a cross or crucifix worship of a graven image, or just a tool to use as a reminder?
- The Jews and Muslims used patterns to keep from using "graven images" They needed a way to decorate without using images

The Environment must be Right

Car parts were made according to a strict pattern. But early on the parts didn't work and weren't interchangeable. Finally the problem was discovered: the parts wouldn't fit because they were made at different temperatures.





This proves that even with a strict pattern, the environment must be right.

This also applies to the pattern of Good in our heart.

Creation:

The Pattern of Design and the Designer

Many people look right into the face of the obvious design characteristics of the universe, the earth, and life –

but do not see the presence of God.

We must test our perception capabilities.

The Pattern of Creation

The Universe is full of Patterns

that were Created by the Great Designer

The laws of physics show the beauty of its organization.

The Period Table

The Periodic table shows the organization of the elements.





Man (life) could not survive in a universe in which one or another of the fundamental dimensionless constants of physics is altered by a few percent one way or the other.

- Nuclear forces: slight differences would have made atoms impossible.
- Water floats when it freezes (unique properties of the hydrogen atom)
- The synthesis of carbon is related to an astonishing coincidence in the ratio of the strong force to electromagnetism.
- The fine structure constant a slight difference and the atoms would not have the same structure

The Projection of God's Pattern on Creation

We are told that two aspects of a transcendent infinity labeled as God have been "condensed" and projected into our spatially and temporally finite universe. One is a revelation, written in words, that we call the Bible. The other reveals itself in the wonders of nature and the laws by which nature functions.

Sometimes we can't see the forest for the trees (1)⁴

Don't get lost in the details!



Sometimes we can't see the forest for the trees (2)⁴

This is a natural state of confusion.

When we are learning to read we cannot see the sentence for the words, because each word is a new experience which has to be understood as a part of a sentence. When we are learning to dance we are so preoccupied with the mechanics of moving our feet properly that we have little sense of rhythmic motion. In such situations we respond to the parts before we respond to the whole:

we see the trees before we discern the forest...

Sometimes we can't see the forest for the trees (3)⁴

... everything is so new

that we are aware only of individual experiences, not the pattern of these experiences...

But gradually a pattern begins to emerge.

The forest becomes perceptible.

J.M. McCrimmon

We must keep looking at the trees and through the trees.

Sometimes we can't see the forest for the trees (4)4

[There was a] boy whose farm or cottage stood on such a slope, and who went on his travels to find some thing, such as the effigy and grave of some giant and when he was far enough from home he looked back and saw that his own farm and kitchen-garden shining flat on the hill-side like the colors and quarterings of a shield, were but parts of some gigantic figure, on which he had always lived, but which was too large and too close to be seen. Perceptions – "sinners"

Pharisees, perceiving "sinners" as untouchables

When the Pharisees saw this, they asked his disciples, "Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and 'sinners'?" Matthew 9:11

The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and they say, 'Here is a glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and "sinners." ' Matthew 11:19

Now the tax collectors and "sinners" were all gathering around to hear him. But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law muttered, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them."

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Perceiving the Proper Pattern

To perceive the proper pattern of truth, we must make sure that

- 1) we see things that are actually there, and
- 2) we don't see things that aren't there.

Remember the story of Dr. John Nash in the movie

A Beautiful Mind

A gift for seeing patterns,

but began to see those that weren't there

Modern technology is so advanced now that we cannot really tell what is real and what is not on TV.

We all need a picture to help us understand

- we draw sketches
- we see images in our head

The Bible provides us many images for us to think about.

We especially need some way to visualize God.

There is a danger for people to create images, or idols to represent their view of God.

Story of the little girl who drew a picture of Jesus.

Visualization Helps, but is Limited



Our Efforts Cannot Fully Reproduce the Pattern of Truth

The Hair-Curler Model



Built a paper (then wooden) model to try to visualize it.

Their venom is like the venom of a snake, like that of a cobra that has stopped its ears, that will not heed the tune of the charmer, however skillful the enchanter may be. Break the teeth in their mouths, O God; tear out, O LORD, the fangs of the lions! Let them vanish like water that flows away; when they draw the bow, let their arrows be blunted. Perceiving the Proper Pattern in a Map

A map contains very important information about how to get where we want to go.

We will use this to represent Truth at other levels.



Perceiving the Proper Pattern -- Distraction

Sometimes something else distracts us and we cannot focus on the Truth.

Perceiving the Proper Pattern -- Covered

Sometimes portions of **Truth are** covered at strategic locations in such a way that we cannot perceive the meaning.



Perceiving the Proper Pattern -- Mislabeled

Sometimes the labels are rearranged to make unimportant things look important, and vice versa.

Think if this happened in a store.

Perceiving the Proper Pattern -- Distorted

Sometimes there is something that distorts the Truth so that we cannot read it no matter how we squint.

This distortion can arise from internal (self) or external sources.



Perceiving the Proper Pattern -- Illusion

Sometimes there is an illusion that causes us to think that something else is present or happening (motion,etc).

This distortion can arise from internal (self) or external sources



Perceiving the Proper Pattern -- Complexity

Sometimes there is added information that may not be important to the actual path we are trying to take (for instance, mountains, rivers, contours)



Perceiving the Proper Pattern – More Complexity⁴

Sometimes there is added information that may not be important to the actual path we are trying to take (perhaps even another dimension that looks awesome but adds no real value)



Perceiving the Proper Pattern – Hidden Information



Perception

Phenomena perceived to be magical are always the outcome of complex patterns of non-magical activities taking place at a level below perception. Doug Hofstadter

Once the pattern "matches", we have an "Aha" experience.

The Pattern of God's Plan (1)

God has given us the pattern that he wants us to follow.

It is so important to determine what is the basis, or the foundation of our spiritual life.

We need to think about the core of our belief. This begins with the Jewish heritage that we are all so familiar with.

Normally, our first thought would be about how we are rooted in the ten commandments that God delivered to His people through Moses.

The Ten Commandments (Deuteronomy 5:6-22) 4

- **{6} "I** am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.
- 1 {7} "You shall have no other gods before me.
- 2 {8} "You shall not make for yourself an idol

in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. {9} You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, {10} but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.

- 3 {11} **"You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God,** for the LORD will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.
- 4 {12} **"Observe the Sabbath day by keeping it holy** as the LORD your God has commanded you. {13} Six days you shall labor and do all your work, {14} but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work...
- 5 {16} "Honor your father and your mother

as the LORD your God has commanded you, so that you may live long and that it may go well with you in the land the LORD your God is giving you.

- 6 {17} "You shall not murder.
- 7 {18} "You shall not commit adultery.

Was God promoting Rules or a Relationship?

- 8 {19} **"You shall not steal.**
- 9 {20} "You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.
- 10 {21} "You shall not covet

your neighbor's wife. You shall not set your desire on your neighbor's house or land, his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor."

{22} These are the commandments the LORD proclaimed in a loud voice to your whole assembly there on the mountain from out of the fire, the cloud and the deep darkness; and he added nothing more. Then he wrote them on two stone tablets and gave them to me.

The Pattern of God's Plan (2)

- The Israelites obviously revered these statutes, and thought of them as the ultimate set of rules for their behavior.
- All kinds of people have based their lives on this list as well, whether they were Jews or not.
- But God gave many other commands His chosen people, that were not really given that much attention.
- The 10 commandments were used as a standard when Jesus questioned them about their spirituality.

The Pattern of God's Plan (3)

God wants justice, but within the scope of His Grace.

Another rule that many of the Jews, and many people today, consider as representative of the will of the God of the Old Testament the Pharisees saw as a critical addition concerns justice: that of an **eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth**.

But people use that to exact revenge on those who have slighted them, and this was not God's intent.

This idea is referred to several times in the Old Testament.

An Eye for an Eye

These two basic principles, or groups of principles, can be seen as the driving force behind the Jewish interpretation of their religion.

There was much more attention paid to rules than principles, and there is a huge difference between them.

One scripture that was a highlight and sacred to many is found a few verses after the 10 commandments, and it is referred to as the Shema

from the first word "hear".

Shema

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one.

Love the LORD your God

with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.

These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts.

Deuteronomy 6:4-6

God says:

"Love me, love my creation."

But the Jewish people didn't get it.

The Pattern of God's Plan (5)

God want Love to be the cornerstone of the pattern.

- The Shema speaks of loving God with every fiber of our being.
- Notice that there was no mention of **love** in the ten commandments, which seem rather stern or austere.
- A careful examination of the Old Testament shows that God wants people to love each other, but this is not really paid attention to.
- In particular, He makes it very clear that there is a great contrast between Good and Evil, and that there is only one choice for us.

Hate Evil, Love Good

Turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it. Psalms 34:14

You love evil rather than good, falsehood rather than speaking the truth.

Looks won't matter (thank goodness), nor the passage of time. We will know from the heart, just as we will know God and He will know us. Consider a person blind from birth.

I remember seeing a blind girl at Walt Disney World.

She didn't even open her eyelids.

Her visual pattern was fixed and unchangeable.

Think about when Christ healed someone blind from birth (John 9).

Imagine what it would feel like to suddenly see!

You would have some sense of objects by feel,

But you would have no expectation of color!

We have a similar transition when we "see" the order of the true magnitude of God's Glory.

... or have them opened by God

- They came to Bethsaida, and some people brought a blind man and begged Jesus to touch him.
- He took the blind man by the hand and led him outside the village. When he had spit on the man's eyes and put his hands on him, Jesus asked, "Do you see anything?"
- He looked up and said, "I see people; they look like trees walking around."
- Once more Jesus put his hands on the man's eyes. Then his eyes were opened, his sight was restored, and he saw everything clearly.

This is a natural state of confusion.

When we are learning to read we cannot see the sentence for the words, because each word is a new experience which has to be understood as a part of a sentence. When we are learning to dance we are so preoccupied with the mechanics of moving our feet properly that we have little sense of rhythmic motion. In such situations we respond to the parts before we respond to the whole:

we see the trees before we discern the forest...

Sometimes we can't see the forest for the trees (3)⁴

... everything is so new

that we are aware only of individual experiences, not the pattern of these experiences...

But gradually a pattern begins to emerge.

The forest becomes perceptible.

J.M. McCrimmon

We must keep looking at the trees and through the trees.

We can only deform the Truth and lessen its value?



Have you ever bent a Slinky past its elastic limit?

When we distort the Truth we ruin it for others ¹⁷

Have you ever tried to bend back

a piece of metal into its original shape

(like a car dent, or unbend a coat hanger)?

It is very difficult to put it back like it was, because

part of the structure was so irreversibly torn

that a return to the original perfection is impossible.

Consider the work of God,

For who is able to straighten what He has bent?

Ecclesiastes 7.13

God has made truth into a certain shape or pattern.

If we were to try to straighten it perfectly, we would find this impossible.

Our distortion affects the impact of the Truth ¹⁷

In the case of the French Horn,

not only the appearance was affected by the accident, but the quality of the sound was marred as well.

It is our duty to present the Truth without flaw ¹⁷

We are the ambassadors of Christ (1 Corinthians 5:20)

The way of peace they do not know; there is no justice in their paths.

They have turned them into crooked roads; no one who walks in them will know peace.

Isaiah 59:8

The truth has been given to us for a time to use, and God depends on us to present the pure gospel to the world.

We must be so very careful not to mess it up.

We must not try to reshape the gospel to our own tastes.

This distortion can be an exchange of values ¹⁷

This is like exchanging price tags in your local store.

They exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator -who is forever praised.

We must be able to determine the God-given values.

Many people put a spin on the Truth

They twist the Truth to suit their own purposes.

Christ is the Great Physician Satan is the Great Spin Doctor

Fraser Spiral Illusion



The spirals are actually circles, purposefully distorted.

Adam and Eve were the first human Spin Doctors¹⁸

First, Satan put a Spin on the only commandment.

"You will not surely die," the serpent said to the woman. "For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil."

Genesis 3:4-5

He minimized the impact of disobedience.

Adam and Eve were the first human Spin Doctors¹⁸

Adam and Eve tried to put a Spin on their Sin.

First they clothed themselves and tried to hide.

But then they had to speak to God.

The man said,

"The woman you put here with me —

she gave me some fruit from the tree, and I ate it."

Then the LORD God said to the woman,

"What is this you have done?"

The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."

Saul tried to Spin with Samuel

Saul tried to Spin even by admitting his guilt

Then Saul said to Samuel, "I have sinned. I violated the LORD's command and your instructions. I was afraid of the people and so I gave in to them. Now I beg you, forgive my sin and come back with me, so that I may worship the LORD."

Genesis 39:13-15

He blamed the people next.

He was not afraid enough of God,

and was probably looking at the riches he could have.

This hypothesis formed the center piece of Kepler's cosmology. Despite rather poor agreement between this model and observations, Kepler would cling to this idea to the end of his life.

Basic Building Blocks of Truth

So taken was Kepler with this scheme that he went on to assign music intervals to the distances between the planets and sun. You may have come across the phrase, "the music of the spheres."

He also proposed that marriage laws and other civil matters should be related to these solids. I don't know how effective that would have been, but I do know Kepler had an unhappy marriage.

Rene Descartes (philosopher, mathematician) discovered a pattern between the number of faces (sides), edges, and vertices (corners) of solids. He kept it secret because he was afraid of the reaction of the Catholic church. Euler rediscovered it, so it became known as Euler's formula.

The Pattern of God's Plan (1)

God has given us the pattern that he wants us to follow.

It is so important to determine what is the basis, or the foundation of our spiritual life.

We need to think about the core of our belief, which begins with the Jewish heritage that we are all so familiar with.

The first level is the ten commandments that God delivered to His people through Moses. The Israelites revered these statutes, and thought of them as the ultimate set of rules for their behavior.

Another rule that was considered as representative of the will of the God of the Old Testament concerns justice: that of an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth.
People use that to exact revenge on those who have slighted them, and this was not God's intent.

The Pattern of God's Plan (2)

God wanted man to see what was most important.

These two basic groups of principles, were the driving force behind the Jewish interpretation of their religion.

There was much more attention paid to rules than principles, and there is a huge difference between them. There was no mention of love in either.

One scripture that was a highlight and sacred to many is the Shema, which speaks of loving God with every fiber of our being.

In the Old Testament God wants people to love each other, but this is not really paid attention to.He makes it very clear that there is a great contrast between Good and Evil, and there is only one choice for us.

Hate Evil, Love Good

Turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it. Psalms 34:14

Turn from evil and do good; then you will dwell in the land forever. Psalms 37:27

You love evil rather than good, falsehood rather than speaking the truth.

Psalms 52:3

Seek good, not evil, that you may live. Then the LORD God Almighty will be with you, just as you say he is. Hate evil, love good...

Amos 5:14-15

Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. Romans 12:9

Love is Supreme

It is clear that the concept of love formed a critical part of God's plan for man as revealed in the Old Testament, even though it wasn't embraced by the people.

The Pattern of God's Plan (6)

Jesus contrasts God's pattern to that of the Pharisees.

Jesus confronts this conventional wisdom in the sermon on the mount, when he repeats the phrase,

"You have heard that it was said... but I tell you".

This type of language is found only in Matthew 5.

First Jesus responds with an introductory passage that emphasizes Christ's commitment to God's plan as expressed in the law and the prophets.

But He begins this passage of contrast by claiming that the righteousness of the so-called religious leaders is seriously lacking, and not sufficient to be pleasing to God.

Preface to the Sermon on the Mount

"Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them.

I tell you the truth, until heaven and earth disappear, not the smallest letter, not the least stroke of a pen, will by any means disappear from the Law until everything is accomplished.

Anyone who breaks one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do the same will be called least in the kingdom of heaven, but whoever practices and teaches these commands will be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

For I tell you that unless your righteousness surpasses that of the Pharisees and the teachers of the law, you will certainly not enter the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 5:17-20

Is this a new pattern?

Is Christ changing the pattern -or using it as a foundation to build on?

Building the Pattern of Truth

Jesus works to break the dependence of the people on the old way of thinking;

He tries to shift their perspective and shake up their mindset in the following verses.

He illustrates his point by contrasting views on several of the ten commandments to the common interpretation

(the old, underlying pattern).

You have heard it said... (Murder)

"You have heard that it was said to the people long ago, 'Do not murder, and anyone who murders will be subject to judgment.'

Again, anyone who says to his brother, 'Raca, ' is answerable to the Sanhedrin. But anyone who says, 'You fool!' will be in danger of the fire of hell.

"Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to your brother; then come and offer your gift.

"Settle matters quickly with your adversary who is taking you to court. Do it while you are still with him on the way, or he may hand you over to the judge, and the judge may hand you over to the officer, and you may be thrown into prison.

I tell you the truth, you will not get out until you have paid the last penny.

Matthew 5:21-26

You have heard it said... (Adultery)

- "You have heard that it was said, 'Do not commit adultery.'
- But I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

Recognition - AHA! or Eureka!

Legend has it that Archimedes was just about to step into his bath when the light went off over his head.

He had been ordered by his king, Hiero, to find out if his crown was pure gold without destroying it.

Archimedes noticed that the water rose in his bath as he stepped in, and the insight struck. The displacement of the water was directly related to the volume of whatever was put into the tub, even his foot, so all he had to do was submerge the crown in water to determine its purity.

And, as legend has it, Archimedes was so thrilled he shouted "Eureka," (I have found it) and ran home through the streets of ancient Greece without bothering to put on his toga.

Do you have the AHA! experience very often?

Does it happen to give you insight to the Pattern of God?

Recognition -- the "snap" of putting it together ⁹

At each perception of a concept, there is the "click" when realization occurs.

When we looking for something (how often do you lose things?), we scan objects for recognition; how does the brain "snap" when the object is found?

We get a good feeling when we are in tune with the pattern, or when we build according to the pattern.

We find it difficult to get computers to perform the pattern recognition that is performed routinely in our brains.
Recognition - Don't miss the point!

This type of language is found only in Matthew 5.

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But He begins this passage of contrast by claiming that the righteousness of the so-called religious leaders is seriously lacking, and not sufficient to be pleasing to God.

The Pattern of God's Plan (7)

The ten commandments talks about not bearing false witness, but doesn't directly address taking an oath. The basic principle, though, is to be true to your word. The law as stated in Numbers 30:2 is: "When a man makes a vow to the LORD or takes an oath to obligate himself by a pledge, he must not break his word but must do everything he said."

You have heard it said... (Oaths)

"Again, you have heard that it was said to the people long ago, 'Do not break your oath, but keep the oaths you have made to the Lord.'

But I tell you, Do not swear at all:

either by heaven, for it is God's throne;

or by the earth, for it is his footstool;

or by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the Great King.

And do not swear by your head, for you cannot make even one hair white or black.

Simply let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No'; anything beyond this comes from the evil one.

The Greatest Commandment (1)

One of them, an expert in the law, tested him with this question:

"Teacher, which is the greatest <u>commandment</u> in the <u>Law</u>?"

This is the first and greatest commandment.

He adds another:

And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'

All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."

The Pattern of God's Plan (8)

Notice that the one who asked the question in Mark's version **restates** the greatest commandments and stresses their importance (also in a similar passage).

Straightening people out on the real significance of the commandments is what Christ is really after here.

These are not commandments for their own sake, but a means of guiding us into what is really important, that is, to love.

Comparison to the standard way of approaching the commandments is a particular passion of the apostle John, who keeps referring to a "new command", which was not actually new.

A new command – or pattern (1)

A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.

John 13:34-35

Dear friends, I am not writing you a new command but an old one, which you have had since the beginning.This old command is the message you have heard.Yet I am writing you a new command...

1 John 2:7-8

This is the message you heard from the beginning: We should love one another.

1 John 3:11

We all need a fresh, new perspective.

Similar language...

This language is so similar to the "You have heard it said..."

Except that John is saying that what God wants now is what He wanted from the beginning, and that which we missed along the way.

Like the Greatest Commands -- Not new, but re-newed.

A new command – or pattern (2)

John adds to this in his letters.

And now, dear lady, I am not writing you a new command but one we have had from the beginning.I ask that we love one another.

2 John 1:5

And now, dear lady, I am not writing you a new command but one we have had from the beginning.
I ask that we love one another.
And this is love: that we walk in obedience to his commands.
As you have heard from the beginning, his command is that you walk in love.

2 John 1:5-6

Love is the foundation for the law.

Obedience to the Ten Commandments (1)

Look at how Jesus talks about the Commandments.

Now a man came up to Jesus and asked, "Teacher, what good thing must I do to get eternal life?"

"Why do you ask me about what is good?" Jesus replied. "There is only One who is good. If you want to enter life, obey the commandments."

"Which ones?" the man inquired.

Why not all of them?

Jesus replied, "'Do not murder [6], do not commit adultery [7], do not steal [8], do not give false testimony [9], honor your father and mother [4],' and 'love your neighbor as yourself [2*].'"

Matthew 19:16-19

Obedience to the Ten Commandments (2)

"All these I have kept," the young man said. "What do I still lack?"

Jesus answered, "If you want to be perfect, go, sell your possessions and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."

When the young man heard this, he went away sad, because he had great wealth.

Then Jesus said to his disciples, "I tell you the truth, it is hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven.Again I tell you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God."

When the disciples heard this, they were greatly astonished and asked, "Who then can be saved?"

Jesus looked at them and said,

"With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible." Matthew 19:20-26

The Pattern of God's Plan (9)

Jesus lists five (5) of the ten commandments, and then includes in the list the command to love our neighbor as ourselves.

He did not include the greatest commandment, but you notice that He does emphasize the ultimate Goodness of God.

In Luke's presentation of a similar scene, he has the questioner answer.

This man has probably heard Jesus' comments on the greatest commandments and answers properly.

But it is almost as though he feels bad about it, and questions further about the definition of the word neighbor.

Neighbor: OT perspective

Look at what the Bible says about our neighbor from the Old Testament perspective.

Do not hate your brother in your heart. Rebuke your neighbor frankly so you will not share in his guilt. Do not seek revenge or bear a grudge against one of your people, but love your neighbor as yourself [2*]. I am the LORD.

Leviticus 19:17-18

This is part of the preparation for laying foundation for what Jesus calls the second greatest commandment.

Most people don't realize that Jesus was quoting from the Old Testament when he gave his verdict..

Neighbor: NT Perspective

On one occasion an expert in the law stood up to test Jesus.

"Teacher," he asked, "what must I do to inherit eternal life?"

"What is written in the Law?" he replied. "How do you read it?"

He answered: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind [1*]'; and, 'Love your neighbor as yourself [2*]."'

"You have answered correctly," Jesus replied. "Do this and you will live."

But he wanted to justify himself, so he asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?"

Luke 10:25-29

We all know the story of the Good Samaritan: brother/neighbor --> all people

The Pattern of God's Plan (10)

The critical summary was asked by Jesus in verse 36:

"Which of these three do you think was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of robbers?"

There was obviously only one answer.

"The one who had mercy on him."

Jesus spoke of the two greatest commandments as being the foundation for all Goodness and Law.

Paul speaks of it in a similar way.

There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

The Pattern of God's Plan (12)

This is very practical (group management survival technique), but not very spiritual.

Is this Good enough for God?

Does this really address what He really wants?

It is pretty selfish:

treating others well so that we would be treated well.

It seems to be reactionary -- relating to local interactions (not global in nature).

The second greatest commandment is similar,

it connects our love for others to our love for our self.

The Golden Rule by itself does not have the real Power of Love.



A Step Beyond The Golden Rule

Paul takes things a step higher.

Nobody should seek his own good,

but the good of others.

1 Corinthians 10:24

Here we are to minimize self, and love others <u>more</u> than we do ourselves.

The Pattern of God's Plan (13)

This is an improvement in that it causes us to think about others rather than ourselves.

But is this enough to please God?

What do we tell people when they say that all you really need to do is to be good and God will accept you?

There is something else to consider that is so profound that it takes our breath away, and that is the cross.

And there is no better way to describe it than John 3:16.

The Pattern of God's Plan (14)

This represents a level so much higher than the Golden Rule. It establishes a **relationship** with God through the love that He has shown us in this tremendous act of self-sacrifice. It reflects what God established in the Old Testament and Jesus emphasized in the New, that the greatest wish of God (expressed through His commands) is to love Him with all of our heart. This means, similarly, that we must have a relationship with Him.

The Pattern of God's Plan (15)

And the other wish of God is that we should love all mankind.

It is only by acting through this love that living by the Golden Rule actually means anything.

God elevates the idea of a relationship into the level of **intimacy**.

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Samson's Own Golden Rule / eye for eye (1) ¹⁴

- "Samson, the Timnite's son-in-law, because his wife was given to his friend."
- So the Philistines went up and burned her and her father to death.
- Samson said to them, "Since you've acted like this, I won't stop until I get my revenge on you."
- He attacked them viciously and slaughtered many of them.

Samson's Own Golden Rule / eye for eye (2) ¹⁴

The Philistines went up and camped in Judah, spreading out near Lehi.

The men of Judah asked, "Why have you come to fight us?"

"We have come to take Samson prisoner," they answered, "to do to him as he did to us."

Then three thousand men from Judah went down to the cave in the rock of Etam and said to Samson,

"Don't you realize that the Philistines are rulers over us? What have you done to us?"

Think about rules -- What mitigates this "law"?

Green at the traffic light in front of you --

Does this always mean GO?

What if there is a car in front of you? If there is a car in front of you... can you just sit there? Ultimately the police will make you move – There is a balance between can't go, can go, and must go.

The Full Truth is wrapped around the Structure ¹²

We think of discrete laws, one here, one there like a single line; but Good involves fitting the pattern over a wide range of parameters; like forecasting the weather, or adding surface to a structure.



Can a comprehensive set of laws be written that is not subject to interpretation?

This was tried with Mathematics, and it didn't work.

Law must be interpreted for Good;

interpretation must not be used as

an excuse to ignore parts of the law we don't like!

We are always looking for loopholes!

Moses and Aaron then went into the Tent of Meeting. When they came out, they blessed the people; and the glory of the LORD appeared to all the people.

Fire came out from the presence of the LORD and consumed the burnt offering and the fat portions on the altar.

And when all the people saw it,

they shouted for joy and fell facedown.

Leviticus 9:23-24

God provided a sacred spark!

The Sacred Fire

The fire on the altar must be kept burning; it must not go out.

Every morning the priest is to add firewood and arrange the burnt offering on the fire and burn the fat of the fellowship offerings on it.

The fire must be kept burning on the altar continuously; it must not go out.

Leviticus 6:12-13

What if the fire goes out?

The Sacred Fire (after the captivity)

Jeshua... and his fellow priests and Zerubbabel... and his associates began to build the altar of the God of Israel to sacrifice burnt offerings on it, in accordance with what is written in the Law of Moses the man of God.

Despite their fear of the peoples around them, they built the altar on its foundation and sacrificed burnt offerings on it to the LORD, both the morning and evening sacrifices...

On the first day of the seventh month they began to offer burnt offerings to the LORD, though the foundation of the LORD's temple had not yet been laid.

Ezra 3:3-6

They had no miraculous fire starter!

They relit it, (admitted their sin) and went on.

The Sacred Fire (a new kingdom)

When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place.

Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting.

They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them.

All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enable them.

Acts 2:1-5

God started the fire again for the new kingdom.

Each of us is a new altar to accomplish His work.

The Unauthorized Fire

Aaron's sons Nadab and Abihu took their censers, put fire in them and added incense; and they offered unauthorized fire before the LORD, contrary to his command.
So fire came out from the presence of the LORD and consumed them, and they died before the LORD.

Leviticus 10:1-2

They tried to make their own nation -they offered unauthorized fire without regarding God; the proper fire was still lit Were they punished simply because they broke a rule or because they disturbed a deeper pattern God was trying to establish?

The Sabbath: Law or Sign?

... I gave them my Sabbaths as a sign between us, so they would know that I the LORD made them holy. Keep my Sabbaths holy, that they may be a sign between us. Then you will know that I am the LORD your God." Ezekiel 20:12, 16, 20

The Sabbath was intended to make the nation separate from the world. Desecration of the Sabbath indicated a rebuff of the special relationship held with God.

The Story of Jepthah

An example of the false interpretation of a pattern

Jepthah offered the first thing that came out of his house if God would bring him victory (Judges11:30-40).

To his horror, it turned out to be his daughter.

He was trying to fit the pattern of sacrifice as he understood it from the core of the OT

It is the core of the NT, too, but with the personality of God (Christ) infused throughout.

People then (as now) try to put the structure [of Truth] in their own terms. Ray Marcrom

The Unchangeable Law of the Medes and Persians⁴

Man is not capable of generating perfect law.

Darius was trapped by this policy --

It caused him to throw Daniel in the lion's den.

Later it caused Xerxes to condemn the Jewish exiles --But another law was added that enabled them to defend themselves.

The law could not be changed, but it still could be manipulated!

Do we try to create the same thing in our traditions?
The Pattern of Things to Come

The Old Testament was a Pattern

for the Kingdom to Come

It was a basis, not an exact template. It was a pattern that helped us learn the Truth.

Concerning this salvation, the prophets, who spoke of the grace that was to come to you, searched intently with the greatest care, trying to find out the time and circumstances to which the Spirit of Christ in them was pointing when he predicted the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow.

1 Peter 1:10

The prophets were also trying to see the new pattern.

The pattern of that which was to come (Christ) ¹⁴

Nevertheless, death reigned from the time of Adam to the time of Moses, even over those who did not sin by breaking a command, as did Adam, who was a pattern of the one to come. Romans 5:14

Pattern: type, figure, picture, prelude, look or point ahead

Christ came to show the perfected pattern

The Pattern of Things to Come

Jesus Christ overlaid His Pattern over the Old Testament

to show the character of the New Kingdom

The Jesus pattern overlaid on the OT: I am the light I am the life I am the bread I am the living water God is my Father This is my body, my blood Hung on a tree as a sacrifice

Much of this was unacceptable to the current interpretation of the "law"

Christ's Interpretation of the Law

Christ's Interpretation of the Intent of the Law (1)¹⁴

At that time Jesus went through the grainfields on the Sabbath.

His disciples were hungry and began to pick some heads of grain and eat them.

When the Pharisees saw this, they said to him, "Look! Your disciples are doing what is unlawful on the Sabbath."

Matthew 12:1-2

The Pharisees were ready to pounce on Christ to embarrass Him in front of His audience.

Christ's Interpretation of the Intent of the Law (2)¹⁴

He answered,

"Haven't you read what David did when he and his companions were hungry?

He entered the house of God, and he and his companions ate the consecrated bread which was not lawful for them to do, but only for the priests.

Or haven't you read in the Law that on the Sabbath the priests in the temple desecrate the day and yet are innocent?

Matthew 12:3-5

Christ's Interpretation of the Intent of the Law (3)¹⁴

I tell you that one greater than the temple is here.

If you had known what these words mean, 'I desire mercy, not sacrifice,' you would not have condemned the innocent.

For the Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath."

Consider Paul's thoughts on the Law

"Everything is permissible" but not everything is beneficial.
"Everything is permissible" but not everything is constructive.

Nobody should seek his own good, but the good of others. Watch out for malicious compliance!

1 Corinthians 6:23-4

Was Paul saying that the law was too permissive? Can there be things that are lawful but not edifying? We know that Grace must not be abused (Romans 6:1)!

He also wants us all to understand the purpose of the Law: It must lead to Good!

Paul tried to follow a rigid interpretation of the Law

...we who worship by the Spirit of God, who glory in Christ Jesus, and who put no confidence in the flesh -though I myself have reasons for such confidence.

If anyone else thinks he has reasons to put confidence in the flesh, I have more: circumcised on the eighth day, of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; in regard to the law, a Pharisee; as for zeal, persecuting the church; as for legalistic righteousness, faultless.

Philippians 3:3-6

Paul had the best pedigree a Jew could boast of!

Paul tried to follow a rigid interpretation of the Law

But whatever was to my profit I now consider loss for the sake of Christ. The Pearl of What is more, **Great Price** Matthew 13:45 I consider everything a loss compared to the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them rubbish, that I may gain Christ and be found in him... Philippians 3:7-9

The pattern of the perfect Pharisee was not sufficient!

We must learn from these lessons

Christ pleaded throughout his life on this earth to not be caught up in "Legalism".

He struggled constantly with the Pharisees on this issue.

We must get the real message. We must see the Truth clearly.

We must not let the church be consumed by what Christ died to free us from!

Were the Pharisees stupid, or blind?

Christ did not fit their pattern,

and they could not accept Him.

They had too much time and history invested in their old structure.

They were blinded by their own perception of the Truth.

Should they remodel or rebuild?

Remember that Satan had to be fooled as well! ¹⁶

This is part of the reason for the "mystery".

Satan apparently did not believe that Christ could be raised from the dead, and that His sacrifice could save man from his sins and free him from his bondage.

Satan saw his victory evaporate in the final seconds.

This pattern is described in some detail.

Now the first covenant had regulations for worship and also an earthly sanctuary.

A tabernacle was set up.

In its first room were the lampstand,

the table and the consecrated bread;

this was called the Holy Place.

Behind the second curtain was a room

called the Most Holy Place,

which had the golden altar of incense

and the gold-covered ark of the covenant.

Hebrews 9:1-4a

This ark contained the gold jar of manna, Aaron's staff that had budded, and the stone tablets of the covenant. Above the ark were the cherubim of the Glory, overshadowing the atonement cover.

But we cannot discuss these things in detail now. Hebrews 9:4b-5

How important is it that the crucial elements kept in the ark were lost forever?

How did they worship without them?

Were they not a part of the pattern?

They worshiped God without them.

How could the Israelites do without the critical physical elements of the old worship system?

- 1) pillar of cloud and fire gone,
- 2) fire on the altar extinguished,
- 3) ark no longer had its special contents,
- 4) eventually the ark itself is gone
- 5) the temple was destroyed (and the older people cried at its replacement)
- 6) the veil of the temple was ripped in two to expose the Most Holy Place [Ron]

The woman at the well also was concerned about the "place" of worship.

When everything had been arranged like this, the priests entered regularly into the outer room to carry on their ministry.

But only the high priest entered the inner room, and that only once a year, and never without blood, which he offered for himself and for the sins the people had committed in ignorance.

Tradition: a rope attached to the leg of the High Priest in case he fell ill

Hebrews 9:6-7

The tabernacle pattern prepared the way for the new, spiritual pattern.

The Holy Spirit was showing by this that the way into the Most Holy Place had not yet been disclosed as long as the first tabernacle was still standing.

This is an illustration for the present time, indicating that the gifts and sacrifices being offered were not able to clear the conscience of the worshiper.

They are only a matter of food and drink and various ceremonial washings external regulations applying Reg until the time of the new order.

Regulated worship

Hebrews 9:8-10

The old pattern was clearly not sufficient for True Worship.



Christ re-wrote the pattern into something more effective.

The Pattern of Worship -- Back to the Tabernacle¹⁶ When Moses had proclaimed every commandment of the law to all the people, he took the blood of calves, together with water... and sprinkled the scroll and all the people. He said, Jesus: similar word at the Last Supper "This is the blood of the covenant, which God has commanded you to keep." In the same way, he sprinkled with the blood both the tabernacle and everything used in its ceremonies. In fact, the law requires that nearly everything be cleansed with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.

Hebrews 9:18-22

The Pattern of Worship -- Back to the Tabernacle¹⁶ It was necessary, then, for the copies of the heavenly things to be purified with these sacrifices, but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these. For Christ did not enter a man-made sanctuary that was only a **copy** of the true one; The Holiest of the Holiest he entered heaven itself, now to appear for us in God's presence. ... now he has appeared once for all at the end of the ages to do away with sin by the sacrifice of himself. Hebrews 9:23-26

David, wearing a linen ephod, danced before the LORD with all his might, while he and the entire house of Israel brought up the ark of the LORD with shouts and the sound of trumpets. 2 Samuel 6:12-15

We were brought up without clapping our hands, etc. And we certainly would not be caught dancing!

Having the Mind of Christ (1)

The type of Judaism in which Paul had grown up had become largely traditional: The word of the Lord, the Rabbis held, came to the prophets of old, but we can only preserve and interpret the truth they handed down. Jesus Christ, with a confidence that to the timid traditionalism of His time appeared blasphemous, asserted that He knew the Father and was prepared to let others into that knowledge.

Having the Mind of Christ (2)

He did so, not by handing down a new tradition about God, but by making others sharers in His own attitude to God. This is what Paul means by "having the mind of Christ." C. Harold Dodd

This is a New Testament Example --Do we follow it?

When you come together, everyone has a hymn, or a word of instruction, a revelation, a tongue or an interpretation.

All of these must be done for the strengthening of the church. Or a dance?

1 Corinthians 14:26

This is a New Testament Example --

Do we follow it?

If anyone speaks in a tongue, two — or at the most three should speak, one at a time, and someone must interpret. If there is no interpreter, the speaker should keep quiet in the church and speak to himself and God. 1 Corinthians 14:27-28

This is a New Testament Example --Do we follow it?

Two or three prophets should speak, and the others should weigh carefully what is said. And if a revelation comes to someone who is sitting down, the first speaker should stop. For you can all prophesy in turn so that everyone may be instructed and encouraged... For God is not a God of disorder but of peace. **1 Corinthians 14:29-33**

This is a Pre- New Testament Church Example --Do we follow it?

It was just before the Passover Feast... Jesus... got up from the meal, took off his outer clothing, and wrapped a towel around his waist. After that, he poured water into a basin and began to wash his disciples' feet, drying them with the towel that was wrapped around him. **1** Corinthians 14:29-33

Is this an act of service, or worship, or both? Is this pattern essential, good to do, or just historical?

The Impact of Denominationalism

Though these items might help our relationship, the forced (and arbitrary) order of them would not;

Sometimes in life we find ourselves in a similar situation, being damaged by the very structure that is supposed to give us shelter and stability. Unfortunately, the church (as implemented in the hands of men) can have this reversed function. The church is an institution ordained by God and if operated according to his pattern, it is indeed the body of Christ. The only thing that can go wrong with it stems from the failings of the sinners (you and me)

who are a part of it.

If you have ever worked within its structure, you have most likely crashed into it at least once.

The Restoration of Art and other things



The true church is an original painting that has been painted over and must be carefully restored to be revealed.

Do we go back to reveal the external pattern of the worship service, or the internal pattern of worship from the heart

We must not get misled by a different pattern ¹⁸

I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting the one who called you by the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel which is really no gospel at all. Evidently some people are throwing you into confusion and are trying to pervert the gospel of Christ. But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach a gospel other than the one we preached to you, let him be eternally condemned! As we have already said, so now I say again: If anybody is preaching to you a gospel other than what you accepted, let him be eternally condemned!

We must not get misled by a different pattern ¹⁸

Hardship can drive consolidation.

Was not the sin of Peor enough for us? Up to this very day we have not cleansed ourselves from that sin, even though a plague fell on the community of the LORD! And are you now turning away from the LORD ?

Joshua 22:16-18

The other tribes were worried...

'If you rebel against the LORD today, tomorrow he will be angry with the whole community of Israel. ... do not rebel against the LORD or against us by building an altar for yourselves, other than the altar of the LORD our God. When Achan son of Zerah acted unfaithfully regarding the devoted things, did not wrath come upon the whole community of Israel? He was not the only one who died for his sin.' Joshua 22:16-18

... about themselves!

The tribes respond:

"The Mighty One, God, the LORD! The Mighty One, God, the LORD! He knows! And let Israel know! If this has been in rebellion or disobedience to the LORD, do not spare us this day. If we have built our own altar to turn away from the LORD and to offer burnt offerings and grain offerings, or to sacrifice fellowship offerings on it, may the LORD himself call us to account.

Joshua 22:19-24

They call God as witness to their story

They were concerned about the natural boundary of the Jordan isolating them from the other tribes.

"That is why we said, 'Let us get ready and build an altar but not for burnt offerings or sacrifices.' On the contrary, it is to be a witness between us and you and the generations that follow, that we will worship the LORD at his sanctuary with our burnt offerings, sacrifices and fellowship offerings. Joshua 22:19-24

Their altar is a replica of the Lord's altar -- to remind them.

The other tribes were satisfied with the reason.

And the Reubenites and the Gadites

gave the altar this name:

A Witness Between Us that the LORD is God.

Joshua 22:19-24

We must be careful not to jump to conclusions about the pattern that people embrace.

We have to look beyond the shadow to the True pattern

Therefore do not let anyone judge you

by what you eat or drink,

or with regard to a religious festival,

a New Moon celebration or a Sabbath day.

These are a shadow of the things that were to come; the reality, however, is found in Christ.

Applying Patterns: Paul at Lystra

In Lystra Paul healed a man crippled in his feet (lame from birth)

When the crowd saw what Paul had done, they shouted in the Lycaonian language, "The gods have come down to us in human form!"

Barnabas they called Zeus, and Paul they called Hermes because he was the chief speaker.

The priest of Zeus, whose temple was just outside the city, brought bulls and wreaths to the city gates because he and the crowd wanted to offer sacrifices to them.

Acts 14:11-13

Applying Patterns

But when the apostles Barnabas and Paul heard of this, they tore their clothes and rushed out into the crowd, shouting: "Men, why are you doing this? We too are only men, human like you. We are bringing you good news, telling you to turn from these worthless things to the living God, who made heaven and earth and sea and everything in them... Even with these words, they had difficulty keeping the crowd from sacrificing to them. Acts 14:11-18

The people tried to apply their religious "pattern" to them.

Applying Patterns

Peter saw the new pattern, but he could not grasp all of it; his view was narrow (only the Jews), and had to be pushed into the acceptance of the Gentiles (blanket); even then he could not see it as clearly as Paul.

We must be able to see (and be awed by) the Core.

Seeing the reality of God (1)

When we see through the camouflage haze that at times convinces us that only the material exists, when we touch that consciousness, we know it.

A joyful rush of emotion sweeps over the entire self.

This emotional response – some might call it a religious experience – is reported in every culture, from every period.

It tells us that we've come home.

Seeing the reality of God (2)

We've discovered the essence of being.

Everyone has felt it at some time or other.

Perhaps at a brilliant sunrise, in a work of art, the words of a loved one.

The physical and the metaphysical have joined.

If we dared,

we'd call the experience spiritual, even Godly.

Children will absorb ideas until their minds close (art, etc)

God is the Perfect Pattern of Goodness

And we must match everything we see against that pattern.

That vision must comprehend the value of the Total Goodness of God (no matter what happens to us in life)

We must believe in that Goodness with all of our hearts; we must become totally immersed in it.

With the pattern that we have chosen, do Goodness and Light always show through?

Do you use a pattern that blocks out all of the light?

Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable —

if anything is excellent or praiseworthy — think about such things.

How Absolute is the Pattern of the Law (1)? ²¹

I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds anything to them, God will add to him the plagues described in this book. And if anyone takes words away from this book of prophecy, God will take away from him his share in the tree of life and in the holy city, which are described in this book.

Revelation 22:18-19

God wants us to treat His Law with Respect!

How Absolute is the Pattern of the Law (2)? ²¹

Do not add to what I command you and do not subtract from it,

but keep the commands of the LORD your God that I give you.

Deuteronomy 4:2

The original Pattern was not sacred, because God changed it.

The underlying foundation of love is!

How exact must our interpretation be?

Consider a package of "identical" items like nuts and bolts. How far do we examine them to find out if they fit the pattern exactly? How much deviation can we stand and still be able to use them? How closely do we examine ourselves, or others?

The Pharisees spent all of their time checking the parts and not actually seeing if they worked (or doing/making anything useful with them They didn't see the tolerance God gives us.

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Consider again the structure of the law

Example: Thou shall not commit adultery

What is the reason for this commandment?

Is it enough to prevent this sinful activity?

Or is it meant to be part of a structure of faithfulness that eliminates the desire to sin?

Remember Matthew 5:28ff (if you lust, you have already committed adultery)

We need to view the law in terms of the overall picture

Are we controlled by the law or by the Spirit? ²¹

Those who live according to the sinful nature have their minds set on what that nature desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires.

The mind of sinful man is death,

but the mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace; Those controlled by the sinful nature cannot please God.

You, however, are controlled not by the sinful nature but by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God lives in you... Romans 8:5-9

But the likeness is not physical. It is the projection of God's acts as they appear in this world, God's shadow as it were.

We are obliged to emulate God as we perceive God's interactions projected within our world.

None of the rulers of this age **understood** it, for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

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God has an infinite capacity to accept our ²⁶ individuality in context of His Pattern

Consider the complex but beautiful patterns of the integration of our hearts in heaven

If we played three CDs of praise at the same time, we'd have a cacophony of noise that would drive us crazy. This was totally different. Every sound blended, and each voice or instrument enhanced the others. Don Piper, <u>90 Minutes in Heaven</u>

How do jazz groups play together? Seemingly they need a strict script; how can it be beautiful if there is no strict pattern?

Man has some natural capability to see the Patter²⁶

For it is not those who hear the law who are righteous in God's sight, but it is those who obey the law who will be declared righteous.

(Indeed, when Gentiles, who do not have the law, do by nature things required by the law, they are a law for themselves, even though they do not have the law, since they show that the requirements of the law are written on their hearts, their consciences also bearing witness, and their thoughts now accusing, now even defending them.)

He can clearly see it if he looks

The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of men who suppress the truth by their wickedness, since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them. For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities his eternal power and divine nature have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that men are without excuse.

Romans 1:18-20

He sometimes exchanges it for a False one

For although they knew God, they neither glorified him as God nor gave thanks to him, but their thinking became futile and their foolish hearts were darkened. Although they claimed to be wise, they became fools and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images made to look like mortal man and birds and animals and reptiles. They exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator who is forever praised.

But they would not listen and were as stiff-necked as their fathers, who did not trust in the LORD their God. They imitated the nations around them although the LORD had ordered them, "Do not do as they do," and they did the things the LORD had forbidden them to do.

He can embrace the exact opposite Pattern ²⁶

Who is the liar? It is the man who denies that Jesus is the Christ. Such a man is the antichrist —

he denies the Father and the Son.

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We must test every pattern against the true 27

We must test every pattern against the true ²⁷

Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves.

We must lock ourselves into the Pattern

We must be able to keep it as well

We must Get It!

God's truth is indeed absolute, but we don't have to know it perfectly here; just "get it". God will transform our thinking in heaven to conform to His absolute perfection; we can disagree with other now and it doesn't affect this. We can be imperfect and His grace will save us, and it will ultimately change us. Leonardo saw how everything fit into a pattern

Leonardo Da Vinci's technique for getting ideas was to close his eyes, relax totally, and cover a sheet of paper with random lines and scribbles.

He would then open his eyes and look for images and patterns, objects, faces, or events in the scribble.

Many of his inventions came forth unbeckoned from this random scribbling.

As Leonardo painted one brush stroke at a time, the pattern would emerge.

An artist can see the complete picture

Have you ever watched a real artist at work?

They do not draw in the sequence that I would.

They work at spots all around the frame, filling in what is needed.

As Leonardo painted one brush stroke at a time, the proper pattern would emerge.

Examples of the "Aha!" of Recognition

PDE: Think of moments in scripture when the illusion evaporated – when the fog lifted and reality set in...

Think of Helen Keller, from The Miracle Worker, "getting it" when she finally realized that her teacher was spelling the word "water" (making the connection).

Saul sees Samuel – the witch at Endor (bad); 1 Samuel 28 Gehazi's eyes opened (good); 2 Kings 6:16-18 David -- "you are the man..." (bad); 2 Samuel 12 Prophets of Baal, when through Elijah the true God is revealed (bad); 1 Kings 18 Instances from the Research Question (good) Judgment, when all is revealed and every knee shall bow (good); Romans 14:11

We must change from the worldly Pattern ²⁷

Think of the word "Pattern" as a verb -- becoming... See the pattern... Be the pattern... Live the pattern...

So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view.

Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer.

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!

2 Corinthians 4:16ff

Pattern yourselves in the image of Christ!

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Temple responsibilities: Numbers 3 (remember the pattern)

Gershon: care of the tabernacle and tent, its coverings, the curtain at the entrance, the curtains of the courtyard, the curtain at the entrance to the courtyard surrounding the tabernacle and altar, and the ropes — and everything related to their use.

Kohath: care of the ark, the table, the lampstand, the altars, the articles of the sanctuary used in ministering, the curtain, and everything related to their use.

Merari: care of the frames of the tabernacle, its crossbars, posts, bases, all its equipment, and everything related to their use, as well as the posts of the surrounding courtyard with their bases, tent pegs and ropes.

Gershon, Kohath, and Merari were sons of Levi

Packing up and Moving the Tabernacle

These three groups were given the duty of packing up and moving the Tabernacle and all of its elements and accessories every day, and then setting it back up when the group got to the new camping place. Every day there was the orderly assembly and

disassembly according to the Pattern given by God.

This is a parallel to the spiritual renewal we all need to experience every day.

From the Depths of the Heart

In Romans 7, St. Paul says, "The law is spiritual." What does that mean?

If the law were physical, then it could be satisfied by works, but since it is spiritual, no one can satisfy it unless everything he does springs from the depths of the heart.

But no one can give such a heart except the Spirit of God, who makes the person be like the law, so that he actually conceives a heartfelt longing for the law and henceforward does everything, not through fear or coercion, but from a free heart.
